If we were fortunate enough to have a volunteer in the school we would like to have them assist us with our environmental education program – we are regenerating an area of native bush on site; we have “no dig” gardens which we would like to use for the children to grow vegetables from ‘seed to table’; we have more planting and garden maintenance to do.</p> <p>We also have a major building project starting later in the year which involves moving our library – this means we will need to shift all of our books from the shelves and return them once it is back in place.</p> <p>We would also encourage the volunteer to share their knowledge of any second languages with the children. There may also be opportunities for them to be involved in fundraising and community events, sports activities and sharing any particular skills and passions.</p>
