GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE (EVS)

The European Voluntary Service (EVS) is an exchange programme financed by the Swiss government and not the EU because Switzerland is not member of the Erasmus+ programm. It is open to young people between 18 and 30.

The volunteer will work about between 32-38 hours per week for 12 months. They will receive a certificate of participation at the end of the volunteering period.

The European Voluntary Service programme is managed by the Swiss Agency for Exchange and Mobility, Movetia.

The scholarship covers the following benefits:

- Travel expenses (400CHF)
- Board and lodging
- Pocket money (136 CHF/month)
- Language support
- Liability, health and accident insurance

With its five places in socially difficult areas of the city, CABUWAZI offers circus pedagogical leisure time activities, mostly free of charge, for children between 4 and 21 years old. Next to regular trainings, CABUWAZI organises shows, holiday camps, co-operations with schools and nursery schools as well as circus pedagogical trainings for teachers. The activities of CABUWAZI are based on the idea that people, and children in specific, need to build up social competences in order to build up a stable and safe environment.

VOLUNTEER'S TASKS

- Assistance in workshops with children and youth in the circus projects (acrobatic, trampoline, aerials, juggling and walking globe, balancing, including games to improve psychomotor, breath control, integration, handcraft)
- Assistance in preparation of circus performances, technical tasks, maintenance of the spaces, construction work.
- help in mobile circus projects: kindergarden in 5 different refugee centers doing educational games teaching children how to share, how to respect each other, how to cooperate in a team by introducing circus disciplines
- networking activities of volunteers: preparing and running circus actions in public space.
- participate actively the strategic planning of the activities.
