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GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE EUROPEAN VOLUNTARY SERVICE (EVS)

The European Voluntary Service (EVS) is an exchange program financed by the Swiss government and it enables young people between 18 and 30 to volunteer in a non-profit project within Europe.

The volunteer will work for about 30-38 hours per week for 6-12 months. They will receive a certificate of participation at the end of their volunteering period.

The European Voluntary Service program is managed by the Swiss Agency for Exchange and Mobility, Movetia.

The scholarship covers the following benefits:

- Travel expenses (400 CHF)
- Board and lodging
- Pocket money (143 CHF/ month)
- Language support
- Liability, health and accident insurance

VOLUNTEER'S TASKS

- Agriculture: Learning, within the period of stay, the production cycles and the techniques to implement them
- Animal care: Assist staff in taking care of the animals
- Cooking: Helping in the kitchen, inventing and making new recipes, learning about Italian cuisine

WORKING HOURS

• ~36 hours/week, 5 days of work and two consecutive days off.

- Motivation, ability to adapt, in good physical shape
- Will and desire to learn, patient, willing to work in a team
- Love and respect for nature
- No drug or alcohol comsumption
- Basic knowledge of Italian language is welcomed
