- ICYE Colombia cannot absolutely guarantee you a place in a particular project or city (region) in Colombia; more than one volunteer could be interested in the same Project. On the other hand, the assignment will also depend on your experience, competencies, motivation, and Spanish level.
- For exchangees without professional experience, social work in Colombia is often very manual. The exact nature of the project depends a lot on the participation and attitude of the volunteer in developing their abilities- in other words, of being pro-active!
- There is always an opportunity to develop your role within the project according to your interests and skills

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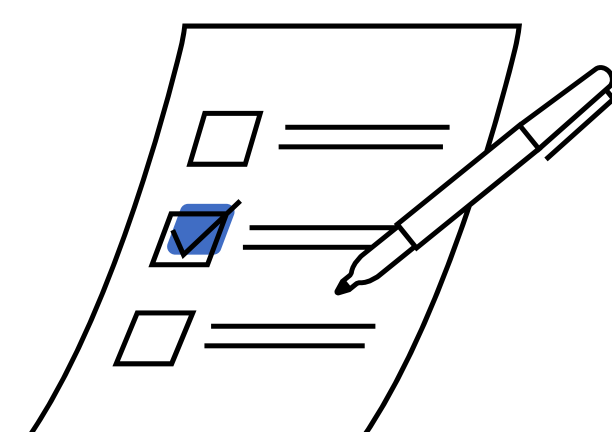

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CASA MUCURA.

Location: Coquí, Chocó (rural).

Duration: 1 year, 6 months and 3 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Living in the project.

Categories: Art and culture, environment, ethnotourism, gastronomy and agriculture.



Who are we?

Casa Mucura is a foundation created to support and accompany the local community of Nuquí (Colombian pacific coast) in the strengthening of capacities that lead to the self-management of their own projects. They co-create with a responsible community approach that starts from a close understanding of the territory and works through participatory methodologies and permaculture principles that include the vision of the community and lead to social, environmental, and economic sustainability.



Project's Activities:

- Centro de saberes Coquí: Place where they research, observe, and create biannual exhibitions and products for each of the trades drawn by the community. It has five exhibition halls: Medicinal Plants, Handicrafts, Agriculture and Gastronomy, Musical Expression and Artisanal Fishing.



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- Costurero del Golfo: During COVID-19, 5 women start sewing in their living room to create reusable and washable mask covers to help their community to protect themselves and reduce the biomedical waste that ends up on their beaches.
- La casa de todos, Arusí: This is the house created for volunteers and the community, it is some sort of communal place.

Community Context:

Coquí, which is part of the tourist municipality of Nuquí, is located in a very rich and fertile area where its inhabitants can live from what they fish in the sea and rivers, as well as from what they plant and collect in the lush jungle that grows behind them. It has a border. The work they do is promote productive initiatives that the local community wants to develop.

They also work with international cooperation, which promotes the local work of the people from Coquí. They want to have volunteers because they believe it is an enriching opportunity to continue with the exchange of culture and knowledge.

Volunteer's Requirements :

There are no specifications on the volunteer's profile. The important thing is that the volunteer has a good attitude, has disposition, and is proactive. It is vital for the volunteer to be open-minded and to be very respectful of other cultures and ancestral knowledge.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- Exchange of knowledge between the volunteer and the community.
- Accompany the different experiences the foundation do with tourists and people from the community.
- Support the workshops they do (Medicinal Plants, Handicrafts, Agriculture and Gastronomy, Musical Expression and Artisanal Fishing).
- Support the activities with children and women.

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ÑAMBI WAIRA.

Location: Puerto Limón, Putumayo.

Duration: 6 months and 3 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Living in the project.

Categories: Art and culture, environment, ethnotourism, agriculture, technology and health.



Who are we?

This project was founded by local communities of Puerto Limón, Putumayo. Its main aim is to disseminate information regarding the culture of Inga indigenous communities and the importance of nature/environment for them; this means that the experts on this topic are the community itself. They do these through ecotouristic activities in order to teach other people about this in a dynamic way.



Project's Activities:

The aim of Ñambi Waira's project is to disseminate information about this area of the country, to make known the cultural customs of the Inga indigenous community as well as the afro community, and the beauty of nature that is not found anywhere else in the country. To be able to accomplish this, the project offers eco touristic activities as a dynamic way to teach about their cultures. They work with local people as well as tourists that visit the zone.



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Community Context:

Puerto Limón is a small town located in the Caquetá and Mocoa river valley, with a population of approximately 1,381 people. It has a wet tropical rainforest climate, with heavy rainfall year-round, since it is on the border of the Amazon jungle.

In this particular part of the country, there are Inga indigenous communities, Afro-descendants of the Pacific and white people. In the project, there are people who belong to these communities and they are all working towards disseminating their cultures and the importance of the environment. There is a very familiar dynamic in the project given the nature of their members.

Volunteer's Requirements:

The volunteer must know how to use social media. Although it would be better to have Spanish skills, it is not mandatory. There is no gender or age barrier. For the project, the most important skill is to be respectful with their community and customs, and the volunteer must also enjoy and understand the importance of nature and environment for life.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- The main task for the volunteer would be to help the project with their social media accounts in order to share important information about the placement, the culture, and the activities they offer.
- The volunteer can also propose activities to do with the community, including teaching English to the local children and adults.
- He/she might also be asked to help with some administrative work.

Project's Activities:

These girls study near their foster home during the morning, and it is possible that the volunteer will go to school with them to support their educational activities. We also offer support and love to these girls.



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Community Context:

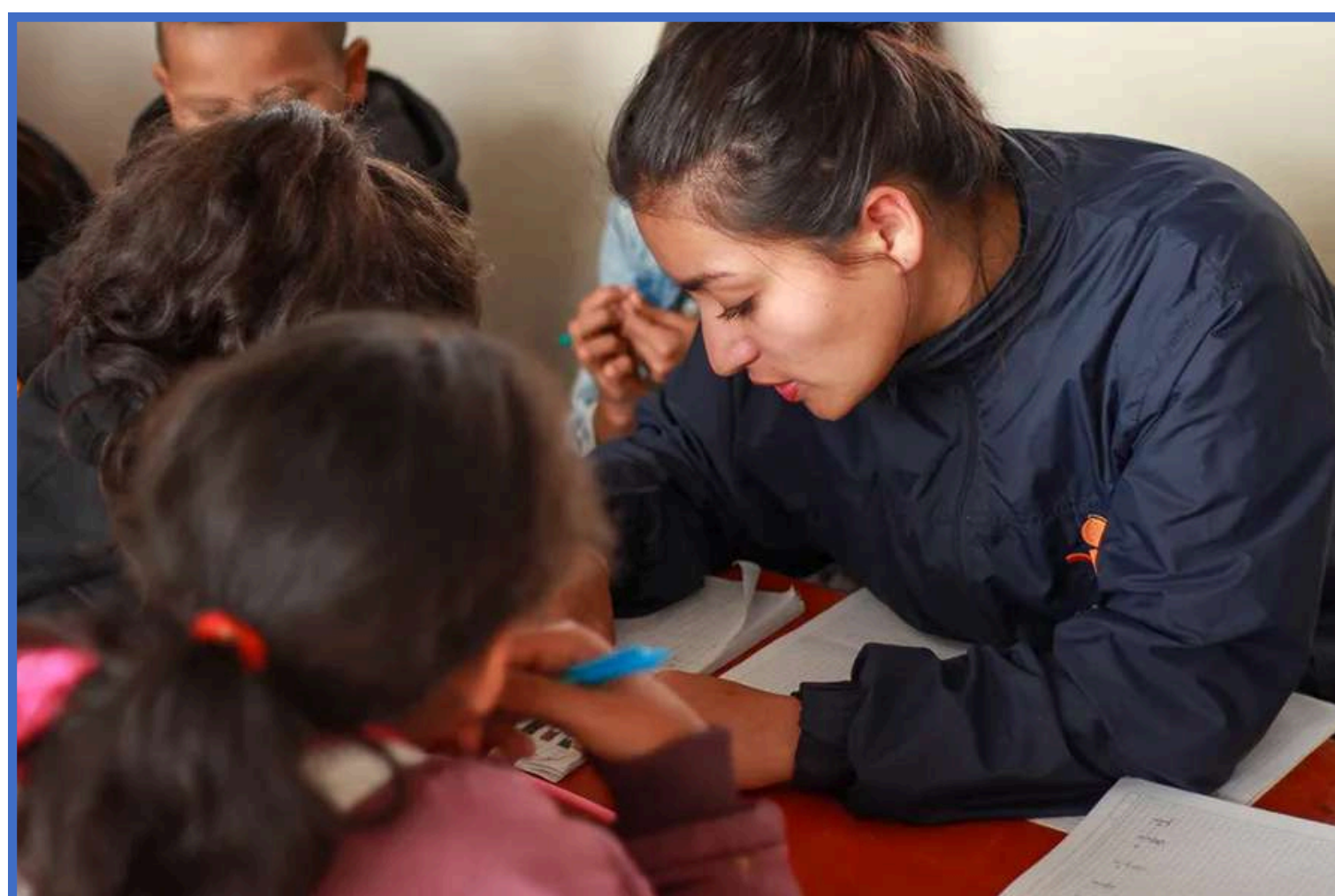

- Support with their homework.
- Propose activities to do in the spare time of the girls and youngsters.
- Help with any activity where it is needed.

Location: Cali, Valle del Cauca.

Accommodation: Living in the project.

Categories: Children and Youth, education, people in vulnerable situations, Gender and Human Rights.

Who are we?

We are a non-profit institution that seeks to provide society with healthy, educated young people, with principles and ethical values. That is why our purpose is to provide a comprehensive education to enlighten and transcend in the lives of young people who are suffering the consequences of displacement caused by the armed conflict in Colombia, or by the darkness of lovelessness, violence, sexual harassment, among other forms of domestic violence.



Project's Activities:

We provide them with love, education, understanding, respect, food, health (fiscal and emotional), recreation and housing. In addition, we help them to visualize and crystallize their dreams so that they become true examples of cooperation, love and dedication in a society in constant growth.



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Community Context:

Cali, the capital of Valle del Cauca, combines contemporary achievements and traditional neighborhoods where churches, museums and theaters, now declared national monuments, are still kept. These architectural values frame the hills of Cristo Rey, the Tres Cruces and the San Antonio hill.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- To accompany and help in the daily activities of children and youngsters (6- 18 years).
- To help with children ´s homework.
- To create and manage your own workshops (depending on the strengths and abilities of the volunteer).





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FUNDACIÓN GENTE UNIDA.

Location: Medellín, Antioquía.

Duration: 1 year, 6 months and 3 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 3.

Accommodation: Living in the project.

Categories: Children and Youth, education, people in vulnerable situations and sports.



Who are we?

Fundación Gente Unida is an NGO established in 1995 to provide education and comprehensive attention to children and young people in vulnerable situations. It aims to satisfy their educational and formative needs, continued improvement and social responsibility, improving their overall quality of life. Currently, Gente Unida has 5 educational headquarters in the most vulnerable zones of Medellín through which they provide food and education to over 3,500 children, Young people, and adults.



Project's Activities:

The project provides education to children, young people and adults and promotes key values and competencies necessary so that participants acquire the tools with which they can transform their lives and environment. In Hogar Bohío de María, where the volunteer Will be placed, they care for 150 children and Young People who have suffered domestic violence, abuse, and abandonment. Some parents don't have time or money, are very Young, or have problems with drugs or alcohol.



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Community Context:

Medellin is the second largest city in Colombia and is known as the "city of eternal spring" because of its year-round 24°C climate. Here is celebrated the Flower Fair, recognized worldwide, which has become one of the symbols of the "paisa" culture (name with which the inhabitants of Medellin and Antioquia are known).

Medellin is a vibrant place, full of music, gastronomy, art, events and places to visit. Its inhabitants will make you fall in love with their culture, where affection, respect and joy prevail. Immerse yourself in this exotic world and enjoy the diversity, coffee, flowers, mountains and much more.

Volunteer's Requirements:

A male/female with social values and principles who believes in working together to generate better opportunities and change the realities of the children and young people within the project. be committed, innovative, respectful, creative, honest and, above all, sensitive to the realities of Colombian childhood. People are peaceful, respectful and caring for the others.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- Academic activities: to support children and young people through primary and secondary school with homework as well as give extra lessons to teach reading and writing. Recreational activities: to carry out educational and recreational games for the children and young people including sporting activities. Other: simple things like accompanying children in their free time.





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FUNDACIÓN PROYECTO UNIÓN.

Location: Bogotá D.C.

Duration: 1 year, 6 months and 3 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Host Family.

Categories: Special needs, people vulnerable situation, children and Youth, health, elderly.



Who are we?

A project working with vulnerable kids and teenagers in Bogota. They work with love, commitment, service and courage, providing appropriate care in an effort to provide sustainable life recovery. The project hosts about 60 children with multiple genetic syndromes, cerebral paralysis, cardiopulmonary diseases, kidney and other liver diseases. These children have been abandoned by their families in hospitals. In addition to this we also have a space for the care of the elderly and street dwellers which is a community dining room.

Project's Activities:

We offer the children a suitable house for their needs, restore their violated rights and care for them. A multidisciplinary team administers this: nutritionist, nurses, pedagogic team, psychologist. Note: you will not be asked to change the clothes or diapers of the children





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Community Context:

Volunteer's Tasks:

- Support the Head of Nursing with activities such as bottle time or helping the children change positions. Support the pedagogic team with different activities General support the children in their recreational activities Helping the children during meal time Reading workshops Special education classes/workshops.





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FUNDACIÓN CAMPEONES DE AMOR.

Location: Tunja, Boyacá.

Duration: 1 year and 6 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Host Family.

Categories: Special needs, children and Youth, health and sports.



Who are we?

The foundation Campeones de Amor “Champions of love” is working with children and teenagers with special needs. Its objective is to improve the life quality of their life. They work with a lot of love for the contribution to the personal development of the children and their inclusion in the community. They are conscious that sport (football, swimming, basketball, athletics, beach volleyball) is the best way to develop talents and acquire capacities and strengths. Physical and recreational activities (arts, handicraft) etc. are an excellent opportunity to improve the autonomy and independence of persons with special needs.

Project's Activities:

- Support the families to help them with the education of their children and like this give them more security and trust.
- Community work and awareness raising of the population of Tunja: to include the children that need special attention in the community and treat them with respect.
- Search cooperation and mechanism to improve the training of the teachers with relation to the special needs of the children (physical or neurological).



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Community Context:

Tunja, is the capital of the department Boyacá and counts with a population of 181.407. It is one of the Latin American cities most appreciated by experts in art history, where the traces of the pre-Hispanic ancestral past of the Muisca, a culture that lived there before the arrival of the Spaniards, are still alive.

Volunteer's Requirements:

- Basic knowledge of sports.
- Basic experience in handling of children with special needs.
- Patience, gentleness, love and good willingness.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- Depending on his/her interests and experiences the volunteer will focus on recreational activities.
- Activities (games, homework, handicraft etc.). Furthermore, the volunteer will be involved in Sports activities.
- During all activities the volunteer will be always be accompanied by a supervisor.





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COLEGIO DISTRITAL BRAVO PÁEZ.

Location: Bogotá D.C.

Duration: 1 year and 6 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Host Family.

Categories: Education, children and Youth and People in vulnerable situation.

Who are we?

Education at pre-school and elementary level for students aged 4- 11 and high school students aged 11-19. Promotion of intercultural exchange, contact with other cultures and promoting bilingualism.

Project's Activities:

The project provides education for children and teenagers (3 to 18 years old) from mostly very poor areas in Bogotá. In collaboration with the Pedagogic University the youngsters and kids receive different classes including sports, languages and arts. The school day is from 6:10 until 11:30/12:15.





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Community Context:

Bogota is the capital and largest city in Colombia with about 10 million people. It is a convergence point for people from all over the country, so it is diverse and multicultural, combining the ancient and the modern. It is located at an altitude of 2,600 meters above sea level and is surrounded by mountains like a green sea, for this reason autumn clothing is perfect for the city.

Thanks to this fusion of past and present, in the capital you will find an ideal destination with history, fun, gastronomy, culture, business and much more.

Volunteer's Requirements:

Male/female able to deal with groups of 30-40 students). Must be patient, full of energy, open-minded, sociable, creative and sporty Basic or advanced Spanish skills (or willingness to learn fast). Preferably able to teach in English.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- To provide support to teachers in their classes
- Develop educational projects (e.g. environmental awareness)
- Support the coordination of classes and workshops
- (English/German) for children, parents or teachers (depending on interests) Can be a tutor for the youngest kids
- To participate and support sports, technology and extra curricular activities.

Accommodation: Host Family.

Categories: Education, children and Youth, sports and art.

Offer integral attention to children and teenagers in Bogotá who need it the most and provide them with protection, inclusion, prevention and capacitation for their lives. We work for children and adolescents in situations of high social vulnerability. In Fundación San Antonio, they can find the opportunity to grow as independent citizens, to build their life project and thus dream of a better tomorrow. Our commitment is a contribution to make the Millennium Development Goals a reality in Bogota. We want children to come first, that their rights prevail, that they are not lost in the vicious circle of poverty, that no one suffers hunger and that they do not abandon the educational system

Project's Activities:

We educate the children and youth of Bogotá, with ethical and Christian values to transform their future and that of their families. 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COLEGIO CAMPESTRE ICAL.

Location: Chía, Cundinamarca.

Duration: 1 year.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Host Family.

Categories: Education, children and Youth, sports and special needs .



Who are we?

The project is a school center for approximately 250 children from promoting education and rehabilitation of deaf and hearing impaired children, but also children with various disabilities as well as hearing-healthy children. Most of the pupils come from socially deprived families. The main aims are to help the children develop cognitive, communicational, moral and social skills, so that they can be self-confident members of their community.

Project's Activities:

Child education in normal academic subjects, with additional teaching of health and foreign languages, as well as rehabilitation sessions.

Note: You will be able to learn Colombian sign language.

Community Context:

Chía is a small town located north of Bogotá, less than an hour bus ride away from the capital (10 km). It is active every day of the week. Within its urban area, there are all kinds of stores that have adapted to the immediacy of the city. However, in the rural area, there are different parks and meadows where you can see a green landscape and pure air where you can breathe tranquility all day long.



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Chía is a favorite for sportsmen. It is ideal for those who practice trekking. On weekends it is one of the favorite destinations of the capital to have lunch, have a snack or spend some time with the family. Thanks to this, it is normal to come across restaurants with typical food outdoors and cuisines from all over the world. Many people either live in Chía and work in Bogotá or viceversa, for this reason the volunteer could live in Bogotá.

Volunteer's Requirements:

- Willingness to work with deaf children
- Must be open-minded, sociable, patient, tolerant and creative.
- Must be willing to attend sign- language classes.
- Because of the second language (sign- language) a base-level of Spanish is preferable.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- Supporting and helping the teachers.
- Especially taking care of one child.
- Assisting children from nursery or pre- kindergarten level to adolescents (Subjects can be sports and pedagogical learning games).
- They also could support the administrative office.





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FUNDACIÓN TALENTO 21.

Location: Tenjo, Cundinamarca.

Duration: 1 year, 6 months and 3 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Living in the project.

Categories: Education, environment, children and youth, Gender and Human Rights, agriculture and sports.



Who are we?

We are a non-profit organization with an educational offer for the public and private sector that requires a proposal in alternative pedagogies, flexible models, strategies and didactics, to strengthen the teaching and learning processes, in order to restore the fundamental right to receive a quality education. In the path of offering quality education and social integration, a pedagogical proposal arises, which articulates pedagogical, environmental, scientific, artistic and multicultural strategies, in a small farm.

Project's Activities:

We create experiential laboratories for children, which through regenerative education, promote principles of circular economy and permaculture.





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Community Context:

Tenjo is a town in the Central Savanna Province of Colombia, where you can enjoy the scenic landscapes of the Andean highlands, the fresh produce of the local farmers and much more.

Note: the volunteer will stay at the project, however, it becomes more of a host family environment since he/she will be living with the founding couple of the project.

Volunteer's Requirements:

Must be fluent in English. Must be a sensitive person, very open-minded and someone who likes to spend time with children for a good relationship with them.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- Experiential laboratories where the most important thing is the interaction of different cultures.
- Support with the foundation's activities
- Help with harvesting, elaboration of material, in the library, etc.





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INSTITUCIÓN EDUCATIVA SANTA ROSA.

Location: Popayán, Cauca.

Duration: 1 year and 6 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Host Family.

Categories: Education, sports and Children and Youth.

Who are we?

IED Santa Rosa is a rural public school located 20 minutes away from Popayan, the main city of this region. The school is open every day, and usually, they have students from Monday to Saturday in the morning shift. They have students of all ages, from preschool to high school. They also have a lot of different projects running besides the academic classes. For the school, the environmental area is very important since it is a rural area, therefore they have a range of projects such as recycling, a school garden that includes medicinal plants, etc.

Project's Activities:

The volunteer will be able to support and participate in the school projects that are:

- Recycling
- De paso en el museo (Going through the museum)
- Huerta escolar: cultivo de plantas medicinales (School garden)

The volunteer might help with social media and the school's web page management.





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Community Context:

This school is located 20 minutes away from the city. There are students and teachers from Popayan and the areas nearby. They have had international exchange students (from the Netherlands and Germany) before, and they are willing to have more intercultural experiences since it has been very enriching.

Popayan is commonly called "the white city" because of the color of the houses that adorn its colonial architecture. Founded in 1537, it is one of the oldest cities, not only in Colombia, but in America. And this historical tradition allows it to offer visitors a wide range of tourist attractions.

Volunteer's Requirements:

There are no specifications on the volunteer's profile, they can be male or female, and there are no age requirements either. The important thing is that the volunteer has a good attitude, has disposition, and is proactive.

Volunteer's Tasks:

- The volunteer will be helping with different activities and events taking place at the school.
- They will also be helping some teachers with their classes (as assistants in the classes they are more interested in), including English classes.





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IED METROPOLITANO MARÍA.

Location: Popayán, Cauca.

Duration: 1 year and 6 months.

Number Of Volunteers In Project: 1

Accommodation: Shared flat with other volunteers at the Fundación Universitaria de Popayán.



Categories: Education, sports and Children and Youth.

Who are we?

IED Metropolitano María is a public school located in Popayan, the main city of this region. The school is open every day, and usually, they have students from Monday to Saturday in the morning shift. They have students of all ages, from preschool to high school. They also have a lot of different projects running besides the academic classes. For the school, the environmental area is very important since it is a rural area, therefore they have a range of projects such as recycling, a school garden that includes medicinal plants, etc.

Project's Activities:

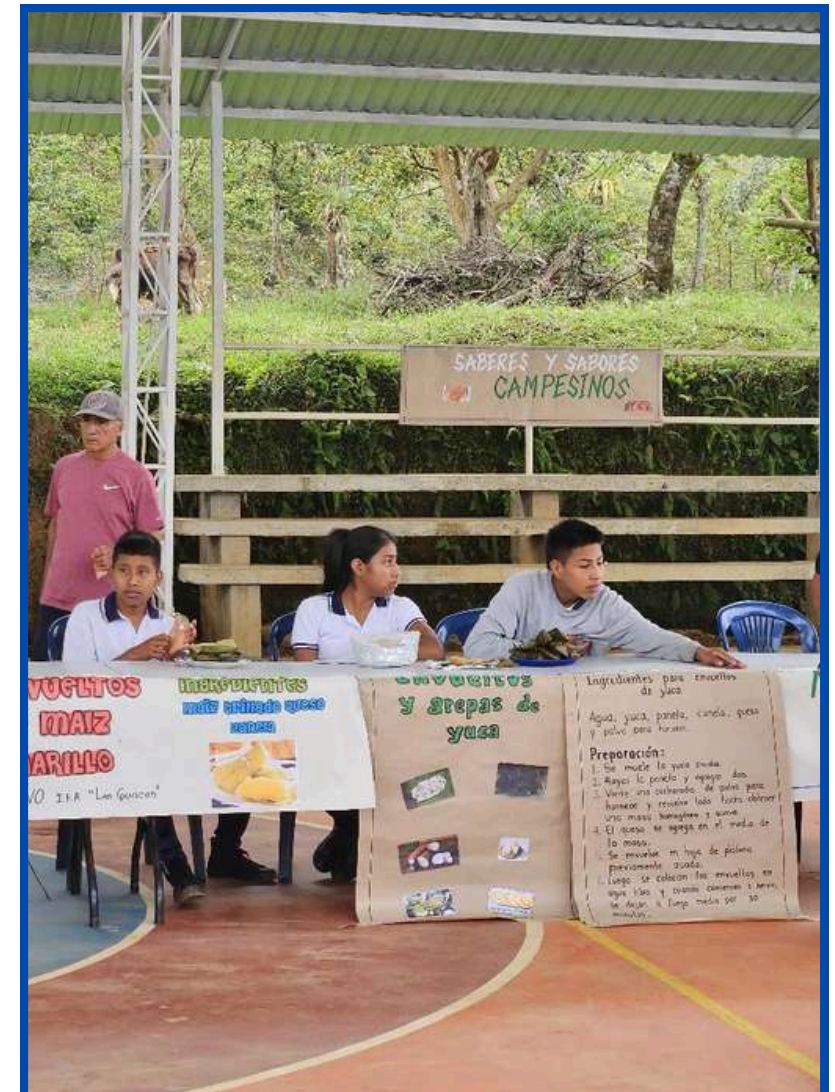

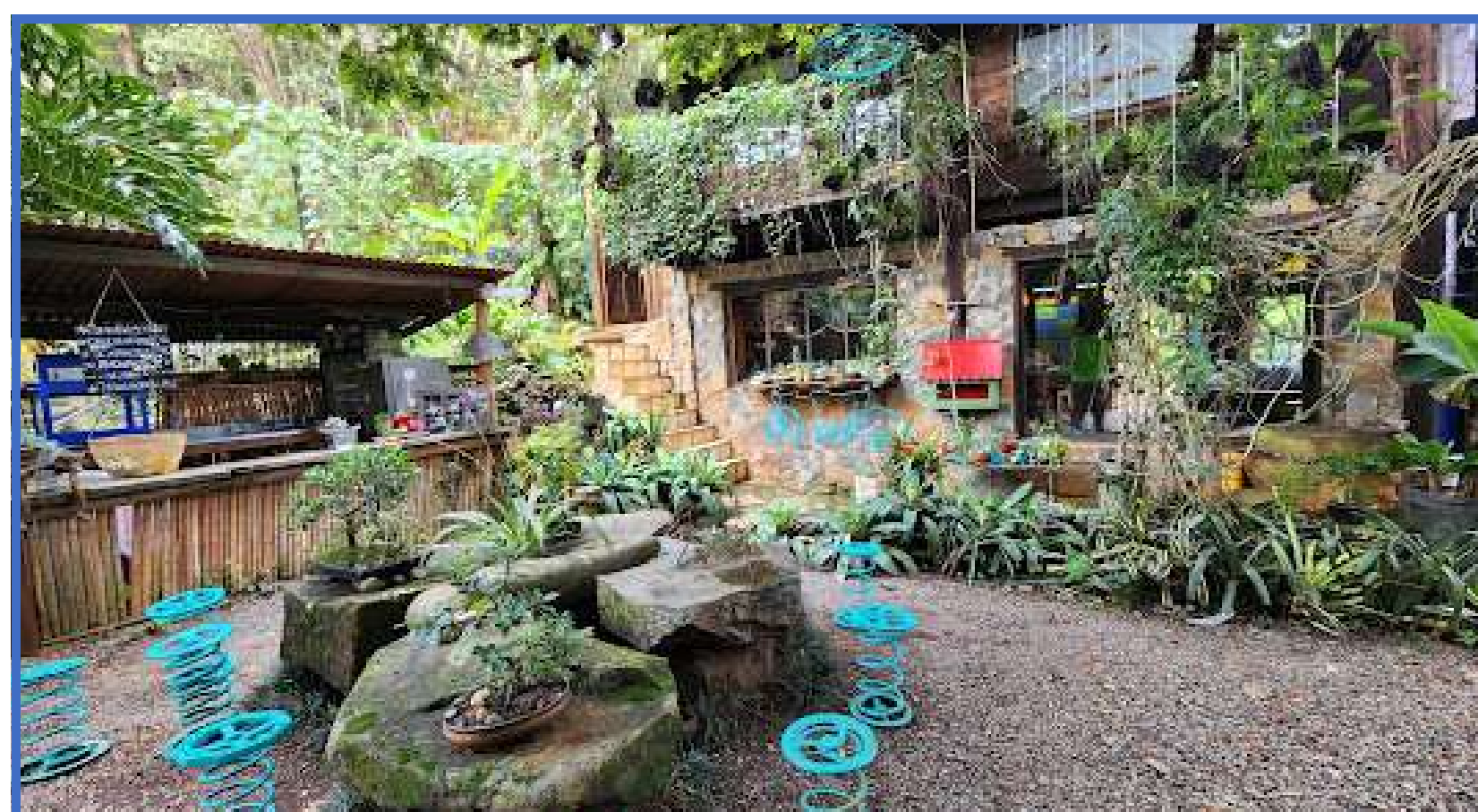
