<p>Description of the accommodation</p>	<p>Since our project is residential, with children and staff living, all safety precautions are taken.  The living areas are cleaned and clothes laundered every day to maintain hygienic living conditions. Nurses live on the campus with all basic equipment's and medicines, to take care of any health issues. Doctors are on call and the nearest hospital is just 10 minutes away.  Transport from &amp; to the campus is available based on a schedule, but is always available for any emergency.  Volunteers will live inside the campus in staff block.  Sometimes 2 volunteer will share one room as most of the time single room available</p>

<p>Activities of the project organization (aims, objectives, actions)</p>	<p>ANANYA Trust was started in March 1998, by a group of individuals concerned about the dearth of schools that provide relevant and meaningful education for the underprivileged children in and around Bangalore city.</p> <p>Even though the Indian constitution guarantees free and compulsory education to all children up to the age of 14, there are no schools that the poor can choose from. Either the schools are very good, but expensive or therefore beyond the reach of the underprivileged, or they are free but have poor physical facilities and offer a standard curriculum which is dull and boring.</p> <p>Most children, who drop out of school, do so because the schools do not cater to their special needs. Education in such critical context has no meaning or relevance to these children. It does not provide them with the required skills to overcome the social traumas or the emotional and physical hardships they face every day.</p>
<p>Description of the tasks of the volunteer in the project</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Teaching English, and other activities like plays, theatre, drawing, painting, games etc.</li> <li>• The volunteer should have a willingness to teach children and work towards the overall development of poor children between the ages of 8 – 18.</li> <li>• Who can help children in their school assignments, homework, Special coaching for Mathematics, Science and other subjects on a regular</li> </ul>

<p>Required skills and interests of the volunteer</p>	<p>The Volunteer must be mature, committed, friendly, responsible and should have good knowledge of English. <p>Activities of the project organization (aims, objectives, actions</p>	<p>Deenabandhu is a voluntary organization committed to the welfare of orphaned, abandoned and destitute children of all castes, creed &amp; religion. Founded in 1992, at Chamarajanagar, Karnataka, its activities have expanded to meet the needs of the community.</p> <p>Home for the children: Started with six boys in a rented house with support from Canara Bank Relief &amp; Welfare Society: the main objective is to provide a stress - free homely atmosphere that ensures each child develops his/her latent potential and individual abilities.</p> <p>Our goal is to give children basic education upto 10th standard (16 years) and equip them with life oriented vocational training. Technical or college education is provided for those with academic aptitude by linking them with sponsors. The children are educated with the view of playing their part in mainstream society through an environment at home and school, which stresses on the development of values.</p>
<p>Activities of the project organization (aims, objectives, actions</p>	<p>Home for the Boys: Presently there are 40 boys in the age group of three years to sixteen years under the care of four house mothers/wardens and are housed in cottages.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Eight boys pursue college studies and are supported through sponsorship. Some of them have settled well after completing the studies.</li> <li>2. Fifteen boys have opted the vocational program and have found a stable placement.</li> </ol> <p>Home for the Girls: This was started in the year 2005 with a first batch of nine girls in a rented house. An exclusive composite building close to the existing school campus is built for them. Currently there are 37 girls in the home.</p>

<p>Activities of the project organization (aims, objectives, actions)</p>	<p>Deenabandhu Primary School: The school was founded in 1998 to provide high quality free education for children nor poor farmers, landless laborers and other socially marginalized groups, our special program for children include Mid-day meal and Health Education</p> <p>Our Objectives:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Respect for each child's unique personality and aptitude.</li> <li>2. Parental and Community involvement.</li> </ol> <p>Teacher Resource Center: We developed a Teacher Resource Center to provide teacher support activates for Government Primary Teachers. We adopt some Government Primary schools and train teachers at workshops where they are encouraged to use locally available materials as teaching aids.</p> <p>Qualified resource persons provide sustained support to the teachers at the classroom level. We also work with the community so that they develop a sense of ownership of schools.</p>
<p>Activities of the project organization (aims, objectives, actions)</p>	<p>Rural Development: Program through self Help Groups for Women (SHGs): Workshops are conducted in a cluster of villages and their agricultural and economic needs are addressed. Villagers from self-help groups are taught budgeting, bookkeeping, saving schemes and dealing with banks. More effective farming techniques are encouraged by teaching basic horticulture, preparation no finding enous herbal pesticides, natural vermicompost using earthworm sand biomass, and environmental awareness.</p>

In this peaceful setting, the children enjoy the tranquility necessary for their academic studies, music practice, and many other cultural activities.</p> <p>Our long term objectives are:</p> <p>Through their achievements at KSV, the students will be in a position to attain more meaningful livelihoods, thus breaking the cycle of persistent poverty and creating a better future for themselves, their families, and their communities. Through their music, the students proudly contribute towards the conservation and diffusion of India's vast musical heritage.</p> <p>The main purposes of the Trust are: It is the fundamental right of all children to have access to education, adequate food, healthcare services and to participate in their community's cultural life. Empowering disadvantaged children gives them the opportunity to obtain academic qualifications as well as develop their musical talents.</p>

Description of the tasks of the volunteer in the project

- Being a volunteer at KSV can be quite demanding, but if it wasn't demanding then it wouldn't be rewarding! All our volunteers have a main area of work in which they will be involved in, apart from this there are a few tasks in which all volunteers take part, these are; children's reading classes, helping to organize activities for the children on their holidays, helping to serve food at meal times and sometimes just to be flexible and help where needed.

- All volunteers will need to set an example to the students and act as a role model.\*\*Children's Wardens – These volunteers work alongside our permanent staff.

- They will look after the children and prepare fun activities during their free time. They will help them in their learnings.

- They will identify the children's needs and help them understand and manage their emotions better. Above all they will provide care and guide them.\*\*Classroom English Teacher Assistant –

- This task involves working with our younger children and their teacher. The classes are on five days a week and generally there are two or three classes a day of 45 mins each in which the volunteer will have to be involved in. The volunteer will also have to prepare material for the classes and monitor the children's progress.

- Helping with our social media will be of a great help. Whilst volunteers are with us they have the opportunity to learn some aspects of Indian culture such as; language classes (Kannada or Hindi), music classes,cooking

<p>Required skills and interests of the volunteer</p>	<p>All volunteers must be above the age of twenty. They should be enthusiastic, adaptable, and honest and above all have an open mind. They should arrive at KSV with the thought in mind about how best they can contribute to the project. In the volunteer's daily work there will be Contact with children so a desire to work with children is required. There must be a willingness to be part of a team.</p> <p>The school is located in the forest close by a small village. We live in a traditional manner;</p> <p>Volunteers should be prepared to leave behind some of their home comforts. Volunteers must be fluent in English. If volunteers have certain skills that could be useful to one specific department, then we will utilize their services there, such skills which are desirable and helpful but not essential are: interest and knowledge in social media, experience in health care, teaching experience (especially English as a foreign language), experience working with small children.</p>

Getting involved with the children in their daily activities. The students are divided into 3 groups according to their age. The volunteer would be able to interact with the parents of the children along with the teachers</p>
