Please note that ACVE works on placements with our projects to try to match you into the best fit as much as possible. Your Preference List is not a guarantee of a placement, but it does help us a lot!

We ask that you read through the information thoroughly and be completely honest when filling out your application form. You should also make sure to read the New Zealand National Profile, as this includes important information you need to know.

Remember that voluntary work can at times be difficult. You should come prepared to work hard and be ready for a mix of emotions. The end result is that you will have a once-in-a-lifetime experience – but don't always expect the journey to be easy! Our volunteers work hard, however the rewards stay with you for a lifetime.

# RESIDENTIAL CARE PROJECT

## Mount Tabor



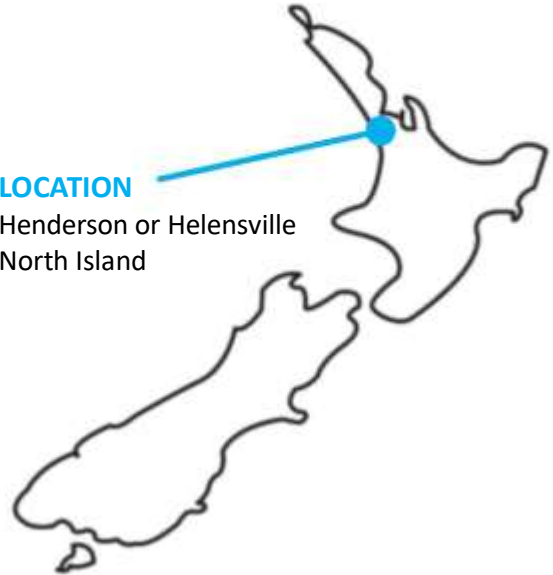
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

Provide a nurturing home environment and an empowering lifestyle for people with intellectual disabilities. Mt Tabor is a L'Arch community that celebrates diversity and choice in all matters of life.



### LOCATION

Henderson or Helensville  
North Island



### VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Mt Tabor shares life. Volunteers are part of a home where daily chores, cooking and meals are shared with the residents with disabilities, acting as their live-in-support. Volunteers should be open-minded, self-motivated and flexible, with a willingness to celebrate individuals' gifts and develop caring relationships. Reasonable English is essential. Note that some of the core residents are deaf.

**Volunteers must have their Driver's Licence.**

### VOLUNTEER TASKS

Social interaction, supporting residents with daily routines and personal hygiene, household chores and cooking. You will participate in daily activities such as accompanying residents to courses, programs, and church. Volunteers will also attend celebrations and community gatherings.

### NUMBER OF ACVE VOLUNTEERS IN PROJECT

2 - 4 – male or female.

### HOST SITUATION

Own room within a large house with approximately 5 residents and one or two other support persons.

\* There are 4 different living arrangements for volunteers

- two are based in Henderson (close to shops, town centre, approx. 20 minutes from Auckland City)
- two are based in Helensville (semi-rural and located approximately 45 minutes north of Auckland City)

### AIM OF THE PROJECT

To educate young people and raise student achievement.

### LOCATION

Culverden  
South Island



### VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Volunteers need to have a love of the outdoors and people, especially children, as you will be working with small groups of students aged between 5 and 16.

**The community is small and located rurally, so a driver's licence and the ability to purchase your own car (or share with the other volunteer) is highly preferred.**

### VOLUNTEER TASKS

Provide one-on-one support for children with learning difficulties, assist teachers in the classroom with literacy and numeracy, assist children with special needs, supervise school sport, schoolyard duty, and more.

### NUMBER OF ACVE VOLUNTEERS IN PROJECT

2 – male or female.

This is a 6 month placement with the possibility of an extension to 12 months.

### HOST SITUATION

Accommodation is shared in a fully furnished house with the other volunteer and a staff member. It is walking distance to the school. Each bedroom has its own en-suite bathroom. Meals are self-catered with funds supplied by the project.

### Hohepa School



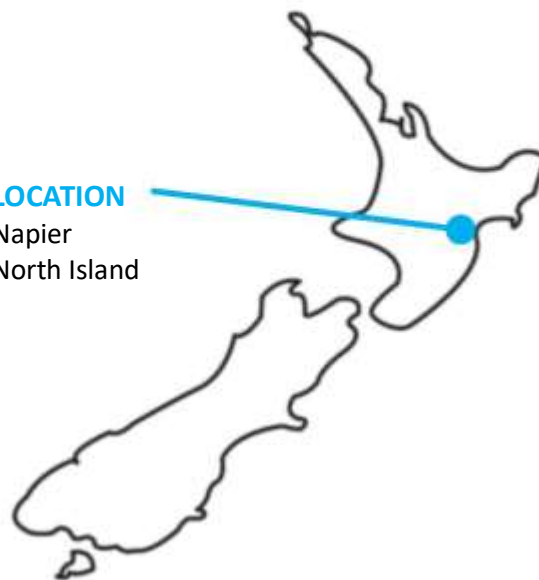
#### AIM OF THE PROJECT

To provide education and life skills programs for school students with intellectual disability.

Napier  
North Island



#### VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

A challenging but deeply rewarding project. Volunteers must have empathy and interest in working with young people with special needs. You must want to invest in others and go outside of your comfort zone. Important qualities are patience, caring personality, flexibility, good listener, being active and open to new experiences. You must be completely trustworthy to keep private information confidential. You will always put the welfare of the students first and foremost.

**It is preferred that volunteers can commit for 12 months.**

#### VOLUNTEER TASKS

Assist the class teacher to deliver learning programs, supporting students in their learning and behaviour. You will be required to build strong relationships and trust with the students and teachers. Tasks may include teaching assistance, behaviour management, helping students with personal hygiene and eating, and facilitating individual learning.

#### NUMBER OF ACVE VOLUNTEERS IN PROJECT

2 – male or female.

#### HOST SITUATION

A private bedroom in a staff hostel on-site. Shared bathroom and kitchen facilities. You will need to cook your own meals with a food allowance provided.

# EDUCATION PROJECT #3

## The Forest School



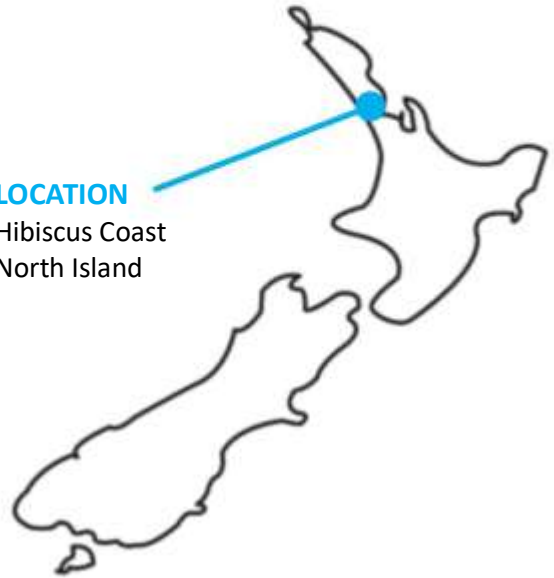
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

A specialised education centre that provides nature-based learning to 5 – 12 year olds; creating a safe, loving space for children to thrive beyond the 4 walls of a traditional classroom.



### LOCATION

Hibiscus Coast  
North Island



### VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Volunteers should be great with children and nature lovers! A passion for outdoor work is essential, and you shouldn't mind working outside on rainy days, as the school operates in all weather, during all seasons, with the children. You should have patience and energy to look after children with different backgrounds and behaviours. Water skills would be valuable, as the school is close to the beach, which is regularly used with the children.

### VOLUNTEER TASKS

Working with children daily on their crafts, play, experiments and projects, mostly outdoors. Tasks also include feeding pigs and chickens, gardening (also with the children – helping them to plant and harvest), some yardwork and property maintenance. Cleaning the living areas and helping with meals is expected.

### NUMBER OF ACVE VOLUNTEERS IN PROJECT

2 – male or female.

### HOST SITUATION

Host family with the manager's family on site. Volunteers have their own bedroom, sharing a bathroom with their host brothers. Meals are arranged as a family, and help with cooking is expected, as is help keeping the house clean.

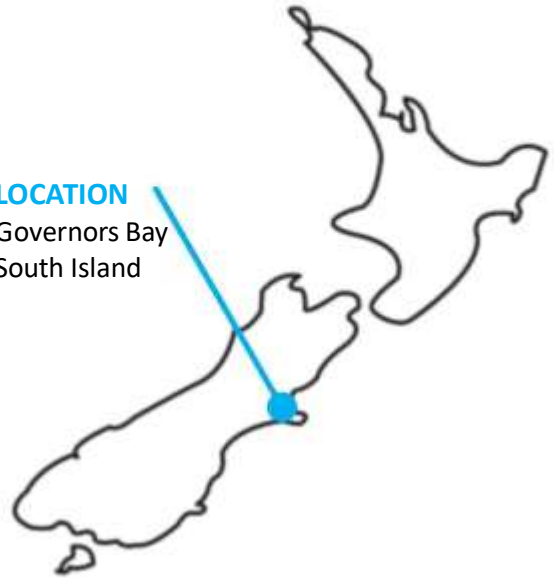
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

A home for children aged between 3 and 12 years of age, to alleviate immediate family pressures which exist for children and their parents when usual supports are not enough or not available.



### LOCATION

Governors Bay  
South Island



### VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

Passion for children, patience and energy to look after children with different backgrounds and issues. Enjoy living in a small (but beautiful) town. Be prepared to be fully involved in the lives of the children in this community. Our care is centered on the child, enabling them to celebrate the experience of childhood.

**Volunteers must have strong leadership qualities, be mature, sensible and extremely trustworthy. You live and work very closely with other volunteers so must be flexible, patient, open-minded and diplomatic.**

**Due to the strict nature of Cholmondeley's requirements ACVE may reassess your placement at anytime.**

A Driver's Licence is highly recommended.

### VOLUNTEER TASKS

Help staff to look after the children who stay at the project. Supervise their daily life, meals and recreational activities. Participate and support the team in outdoor activities with children. Some cleaning and kitchen work. Volunteers work at different times in duos, so you must be OK with shift-work.

## Finlay Park Adventure Camp



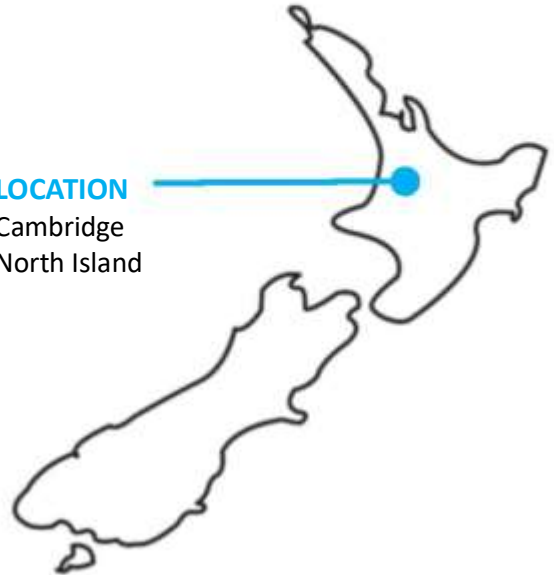
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

Finlay Park is a Christian Camp and would suit a volunteer who is either Christian, or open to and respectful of Christian beliefs.

Upon a 12-month commitment, volunteers can receive certification in some outdoor activities and instruction.

**This is a 12-month placement. Volunteers need to be prepared to commit for a full year.**

### VOLUNTEER TASKS

The volunteer will have a rotation of tasks such as kitchen work, grounds work, cleaning, and instructing activities like rock wall, crate stack, go-carting, rafting, archery, and running sports programs.

### NUMBER OF ACVE VOLUNTEERS IN PROJECT

2 - 4 – male or female.

### HOST SITUATION

Volunteers get their own room on-site with ensuite bathroom. Kitchen and living areas are shared. Funds are supplied to get your own food and self-cater.

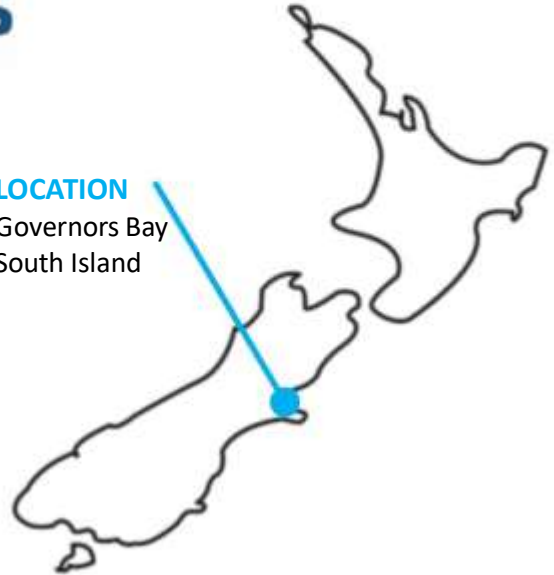
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

## Lakes Ranch



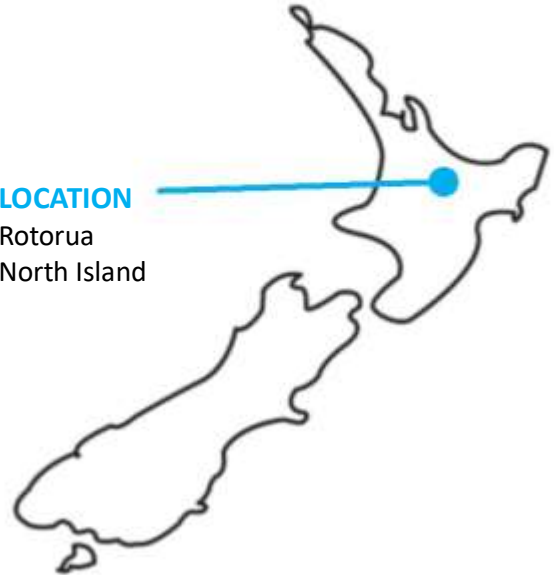
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

A rotation of tasks including building projects, cleaning, program assistant, activity instructor, and kitchen duties.

Volunteers may also be working with horses. You may also assist with the annual Tough Guy and Gal Mud Run Challenge (August only).

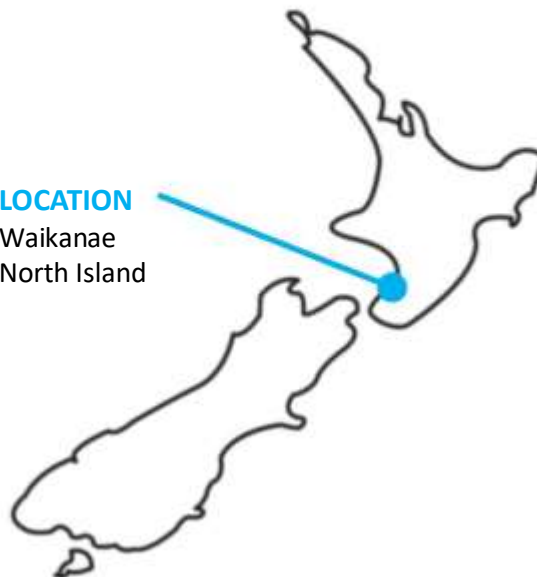
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

Volunteers are given rostered work including housekeeping, kitchen work, activities and facilities departments. Tasks could include wash up, food preparation, baking, instructing activities, housekeeping, gardening and supporting the team facilitating programmes with children.

Examples of activities include kayaking, crate stack, rifles, archery, raft building, rock wall, low ropes and team initiatives.

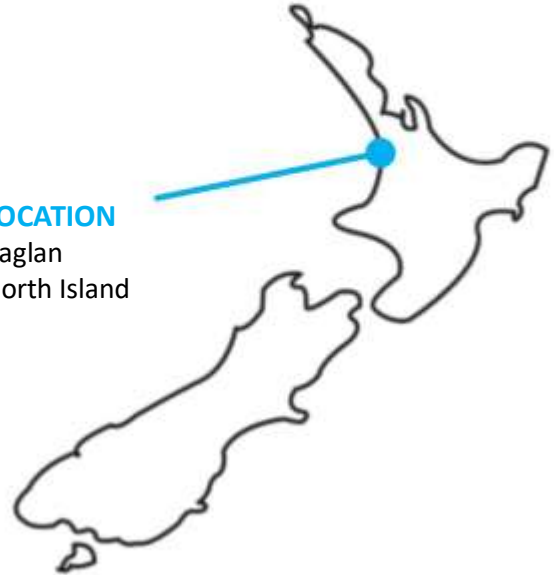

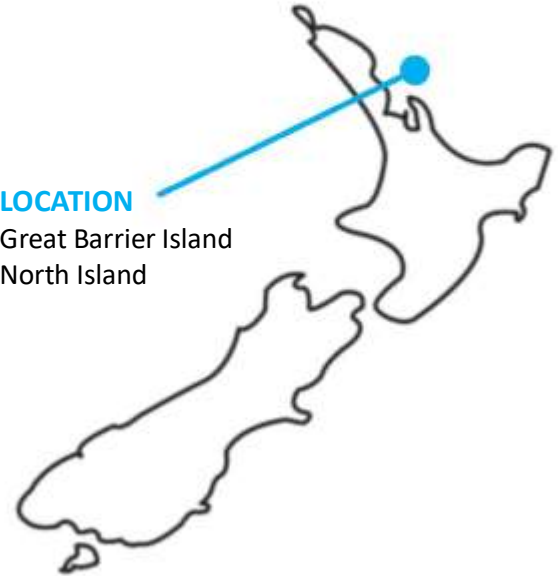
### AIM OF THE PROJECT

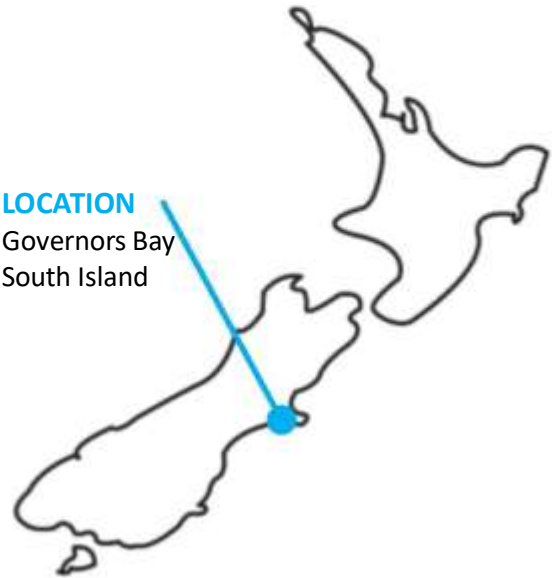
### AIM OF THE PROJECT
