

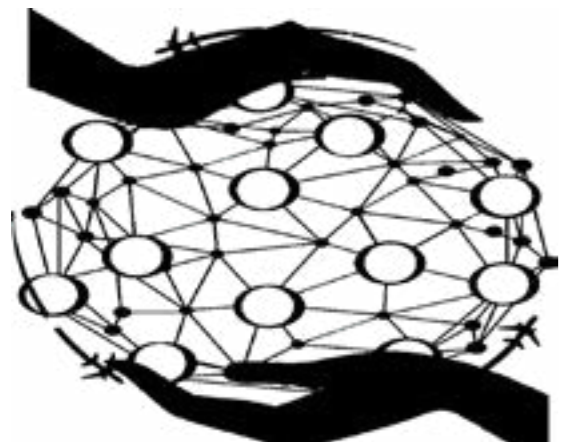

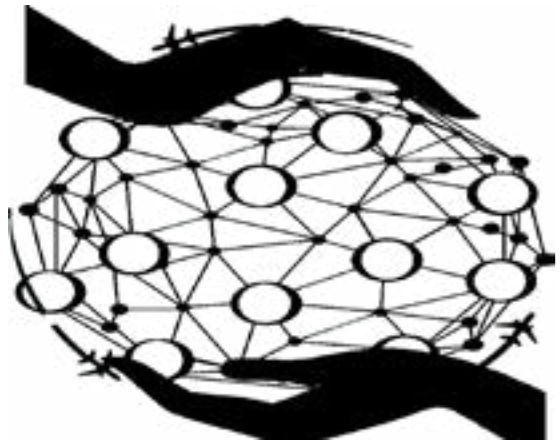

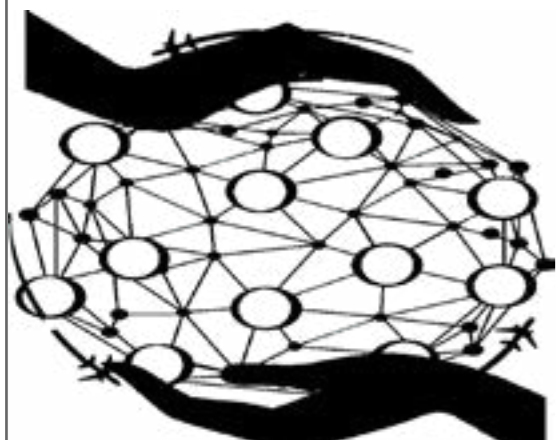

SPLENDOR HOME CENTER STEPS

LOCATION

Los Olivos, Lima-Peru

COMMUNITY CONTEXT

The Splendor home is located in an urban middle low income neighborhood, in the north side of Lima.

TYPE OF PROJECT

Nursing home

STEPS NOTICES

Project is available all the time during the year, Volunteer must have basic Spanish level.

AIMS OF THE PROJECT

Splendor Home is a place that hosts elderly people (dependent and/or independent). The beneficiaries will be provided with a safe environment that aims to allow them to enjoy activities and spaces of people with the same age and situation. Most of the beneficiaries were abandoned by their families due to lack of resources or because they are ill.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Provide meals per day, recreational activities, accompaniment in the house and outside the house, health assistance, etc.

VOLUNTEER'S REQUIREMENTS

Some health and caring knowledge.

VOLUNTEER'S TASKS

The volunteer will help doing different tasks, most of the time the volunteer will assist the staff (this means that they will help the health, administrative and home staff). Their activities will differ according to the planned activities. From helping to prepare the meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), to accompany the elderly to do their activities. As well, they will have to prepare workshops (morning and evening) for the beneficiaries.

San Borja Lima-Peru

COMMUNITY CONTEXT

San borja is a urban district located in the center east of Lima. It is a quiet district.

TYPE OF PROJECT

Education, disable people, and cultural

STEPS NOTICES

Minimun time is 2 months. Activities will change during summer break. On summer, the project will provide artistical workshops, musical or art knowledge will be desirable

AIMS OF THE PROJECT

Fray Masias is a project that offers services for disable children and adults; in this place the students will have access to an specialized education. It offers academic, cultural, artistic and medical services and workshops.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Provide safe a secure environment for disable people, in which, they can learn academics, artistical, cultural subjects.

VOLUNTEER'S REQUIREMENTS

Spanish knowledge. Some experience working with disable adults or children. If possible some knowledge of dacing and music.

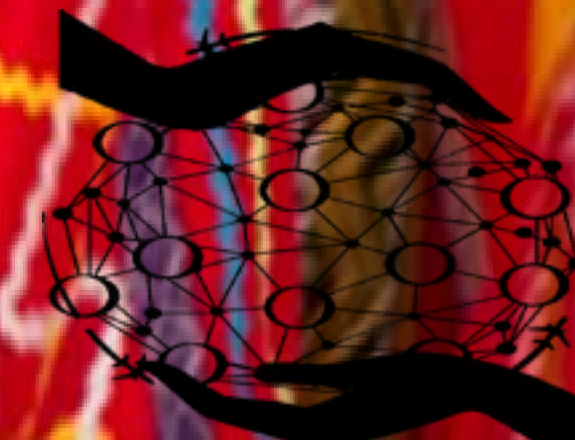
VOLUNTEER'S TASKS

The volunteer will help doing different tasks, however, the main duty will be to support the teacher during the class, including taking care of the students, assist during the academic and cultural lessons and carry out some workshops.

LOCATION

Santiago de Surco - Lima

COMMUNITY CONTEXT

Santiago de Surcos is a urban district located in the center of Lima, it is a quiet district.

TYPE OF PROJECT

Children, teenagers, assistance of population on risk

STEPS NOTICES

Project is open all the time during the year. Short term volunteers should have basic spanish level.

AIMS OF THE PROJECT

“La casita de la Paz” provides a safe environment for rural children and teenagers that are coming to Lima to have cancer treatment, treatment for burns, brain paralysis or Down’s syndrome therapies.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

“La casita de la Paz” offers a place to rest before and after the medical intervention or therapies, as well, all the beneficiaries and accompanying person have access to food and workshops during their time in the house. Most of the beneficiaries come from for rural areas or indigenous communities, thus, the beneficiaries and their accompanying person will be provided with hosting. While beneficiaries are receiving treatment the project will help the accompanying person to settle down in the city.

VOLUNTEER’S REQUIREMENTS

Spanish knowledge. The volunteer will have to be willing to help, they have to be proactive and organized, with some artistical skills.

VOLUNTEER’S TASKS

The Volunteer will have to help in different activities, since help the administrative team to supervise the activities in the house (To control the activities in the house for the parents and children). As well, they will have to carry out workshops with the children, help to prepare food and help to feed them, finally, the volunteers will have to help with the promotion of the house on social media (photography or design material)

LOCATION

Pachacamac, Lima - Peru

COMMUNITY CONTEXT

The project is located in an rural area, located in the south east of Lima. It is 1 hour away from the center, almost one hour bus trip.

TYPE OF PROJECT

Host center for children

HOSTING SITUATION

Living in the project

STEPS NOTICES

Project will receive short term volunteers between January to March or June to August.

AIMS OF THE PROJECT

Mundo Libre provides a safe environment and place for children and teenagers that have been living on the streets or comes from violent environments. One of the aims of Mundo Libre is to give back the dignity and values that the children lost while living in the streets, through the consequences of drugs, sex exploitation, violence, etc. so they can return to society.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

Mundo Libre offers spaces with psicologic therapy, academic workshops, health assistance and spirituality spaces. The project Host over 40 children (girls and boys) between 9 and 17 years old.

VOLUNTEER'S REQUIREMENTS

The volunteer must be at least 18 years old and have intermediate Spanish knowledge. They should have some experience working with children. Artistic skills are desirable.

VOLUNTEER'S TASKS

The volunteers will have to assist in the different areas (health, administrative, social work). Volunteers will receive training and according to their skills will be assigned to a specific area. During their time on the project they will take on more responsibilities, as the volunteers get to a deeper understanding of the needs and required activities.



CALLAO



LOCATION

Callao, Callao - Peru

COMMUNITY CONTEXT

The home Posada de Belen, is located at the center of Callao, near to Peru's most important port. It is a city with some social conflicts

TYPE OF PROJECT

Host center for children

STEPS NOTICES

Project will not receive short term volunteers from January 1st to March 15th and July 15th to August 15th. Short term work placement will be with external children instead of internal children

AIMS OF THE PROJECT

- Host children of scholar age that have been abandoned, providing a safe place in which they can growth up away from gangs, provide a good environment so they can feel love and tranquility.
- Grant spaces for family reunification, provide workshops about the importance of family. Emphasize the importance of Christianity.
- Show solidarity to children and families so they can have support during hard moments and overcome them.

PROJECT ACTIVITIES

The project has some activities such as: hosting home for children, show them to pray and find guidance on christianity, academic advising, provide academic material and spaces to study, provide quality food, health services and meds, psychological assistance and workshops, offer recreational spaces, create cultural spaces and encourage dialogue and training seminars for parents.

VOLUNTEER'S REQUIREMENTS

The volunteer should be at least 18 years old, have intermediate Spanish knowledge and some experience working with children.

VOLUNTEER'S TASKS

The volunteer will be an academic assistance by running workshops or assisting the children with the homework as well as being part of the daily activities such as playing with the children, prepare food, cleaning etc. They will also manage the social media communication for the project.
