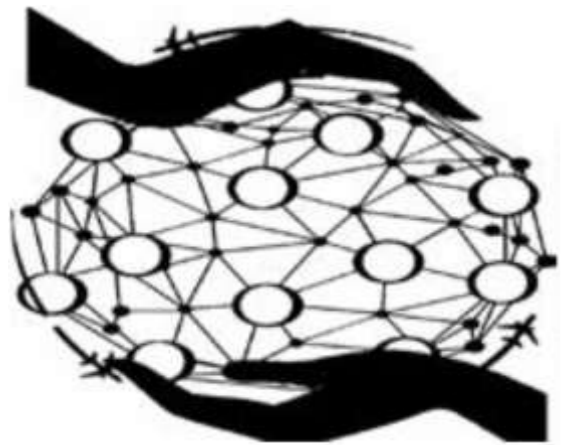

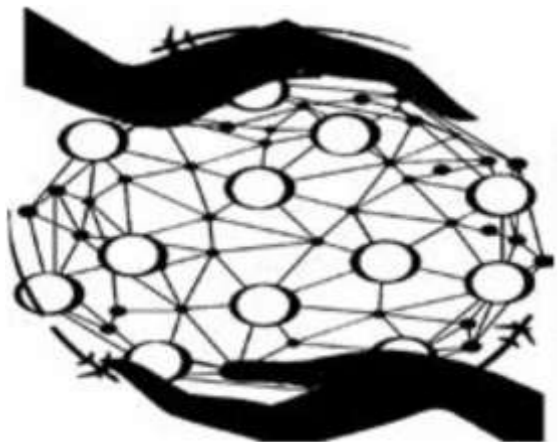

The project works with psychologists, social workers, sex education workshops, etc. to assist them and spirituality spaces.

**VOLUNTEER'S
REQUIREMENTS**

The project Host over 400 children (between 9 and 17 years old). The volunteers must be at least 18 years old and have intermediate Spanish knowledge. They should have different areas (health, administrative, social work).

Volunteers will receive training and according to their skills will be assigned to a specific area. During their time on the project they will take on more responsibilities, as the volunteers get to a deeper understanding of the needs and required activities.

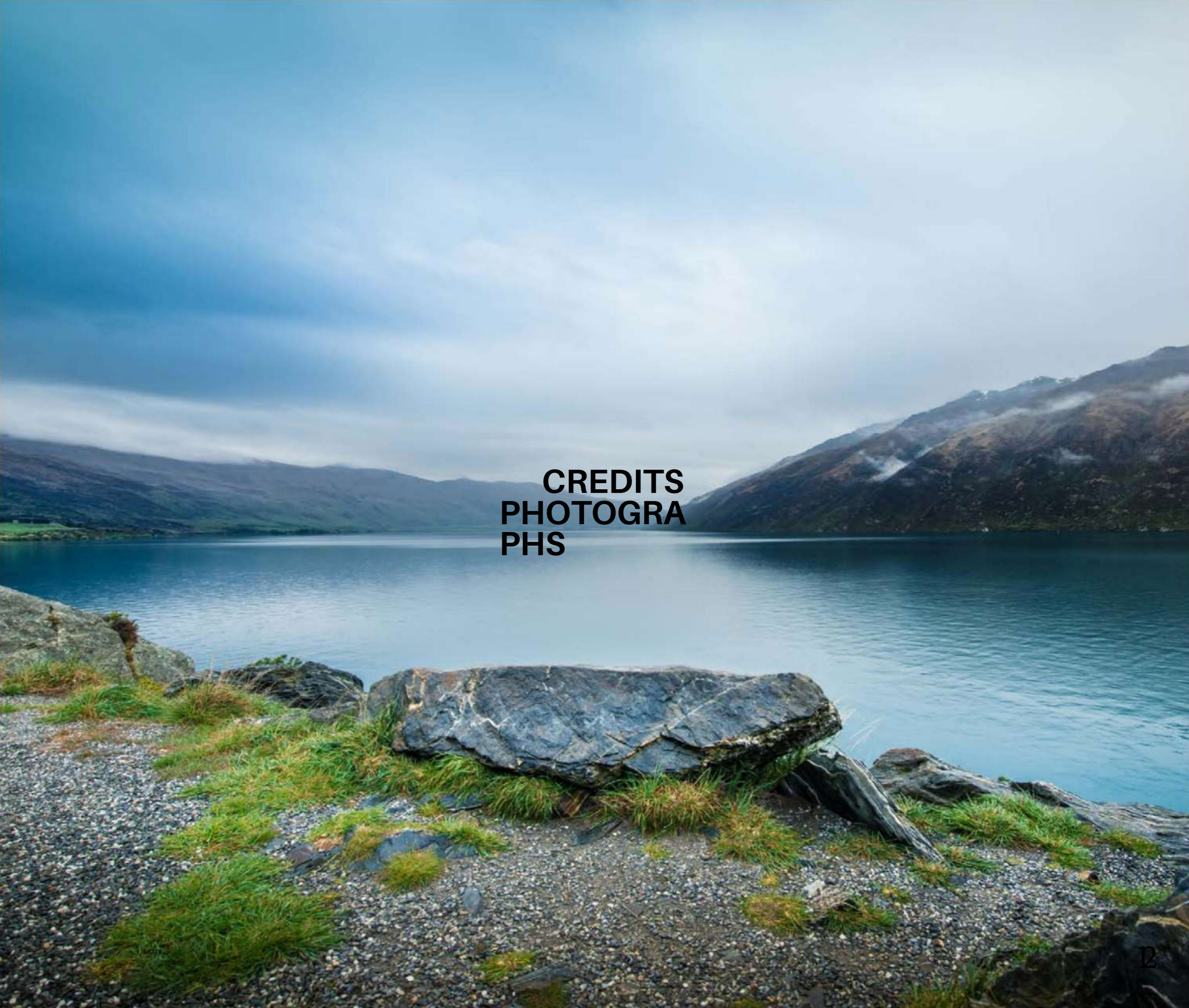
