

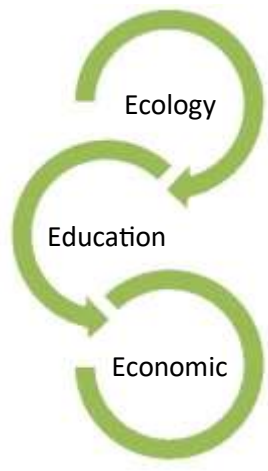

ECOLOGY PROJECTS

Mazingira Plus

Description

Mazingira is a Swahili word that means Environment. Mazingira Plus is a youth-led and non-profit organization which established in 2019 with a vision to envision having a nation that is a clean, healthy, and well-conserved environment. Activities and program that Mazingira Plus offers include;

- The Green Schools program, the aims is to equip children and young people with right knowledge on at source waste segregation, composting, climate change adaptation and mitigation options, conservation awareness and sustainability. Recently, the program operates in 30 secondary schools and it impacted over 200,000 young people.
- Mangrove Conservation Project, this is an Ecosystem-based adaptation/nature-based solution to climate change. The project started in 2020 as the outcome of the World Mangrove Day commemoration where we noticed the devastation of climate change impact due to seawater raise that destructs coastal vegetation, beach erosion, Loss and Damage (destruction of properties), loss of fertile land etc.

Location

The project located in Dar es Salaam, the city lying on the East African coastline with a large natural harbor. The population of the city is about 10 million inhabitants making it the largest city in the country.

As the commercial and industrial capital of the country, Dar es Salaam hosts a much higher concentration of trade, services and manufacturing than elsewhere in Tanzania, contributing 17% to the national GDP.

TEG Tanzania

Description

TEG Tanzania is a youth-centered organization in Morogoro which registered in 2014. "Tengeneza" means building. The purpose of the organization is to build space and empower young people with skills development.

TEG Tanzania has diversity activities on climate justice such as environment protection in the range of Uluguru Mountains include raise awareness for the community around the mountains and trees planting. Also, natural resource management include the protection of source of water, rivers and forest; Eco tourism, restoration of biodiversity, and cultural heritage restoration.

Location

TEG Tanzania is located in Morogoro region. The city is known for some of its popular attractions which include Mikumi National Park, Udzungwa and Uluguru Mountains, and Waterfalls. Along with tourist attractions, the Morogoro region is the agricultural land of Tanzania. Also, the city is known for the educational centers and the hospitals promoting the missionary believe.

The forest area and the birdlife and the flora and fauna aids to the tourism making the city suitable for adventure and leisure. Furthermore, Morogoro region located in the eastern part of Tanzania, approximately 196 kilometers west of Dar es Salaam and it approximately 4 hours by bus from Dar es Salaam. The region also known as "Mji kasoro bahari" which translates to the city without ocean/port and its population is about 458,000 people.

Dar es Salaam Zoo

Description

Dar es Salaam Zoo is the private animal park which is designed to provide unique and exotic relaxation, knowledge and Safe natural environment for both adults and children. As a popular natural attraction, the zoo offers visitors day tours, school holiday programs, venue hire and regular events for the public.

The project provides an excellent opportunity for professionals who wish to study natural science through interacting directly with animals and plants both wild and domestic which are found in the ZOO.

Volunteer activities

Dar es Salaam Zoo located at Kigamboni in Dar es Salaam where surrounded by nice beaches like Kipepeo, Mikadi, Dege, South beach and many more. The place can be reached easy by ferry from the city centre or by a car from the airport via Nyerere Bridge at Kurasini.



EDUCATION PROJECTS

GRACE PRE & PRIMARY SCHOOL

Description

Grace Pre & Primary School is a Christian educational institution whose motto is to groom the future professions by bridging the gap between theory and practice, classroom and reality. The school offers a safe learning space for pre-unit and grade 1 to 7 with variety of subjects such as mathematics, English as language for communication, science, geography, civics, computer literacy, sports and games.

Volunteer activities

- Supporting the local teachers with English and other subjects such as mathematics, science and computer literacy.
- Working in the nursery to look after the younger kids.
- Volunteers can also stay after school hours to assist the students who struggle with English and other subjects.
- Professional teachers can provide further support by training the teaching approach staff.
- Organizing sports and games as extra curriculum for children development

Grace Pre & Primary School found in Dar es Salaam approximately 9 kilometres from the city center. The project easily accessible by a public transport (dala-dala).

Description

MAGESA Open School is the private institution founded in 2017 for the purpose of creating a safe space for children at Gongo la Mboto in Dar es Salaam to learn and leisure whereas their parents are at work. The project offers the early childhood education for children from 2 – 6 years old. The kids learn a variety child development curriculum such as counting, drawing and painting.

Furthermore, MAGESA Open School runs a school transition program whereby adolescent girls and boys are well trained to start their secondary studies. In this program, adolescents taught a diversity subjects and topics for their personal development such as English language for communication, behavior change, personal hygiene management, leadership and financial management.

Volunteer activities

- Teaching English language for adolescent youth
- Facilitating either behavior change, personal hygiene management, leadership or financial management skills
- Teaching children to count and reading alphabet in English
- Teaching children to draw, paint and sing
- Organizing sports and games
- Coaching swimming class for children
- Supporting the local teachers with English and other subjects such as mathematics, science
- Professional teachers can provide further support by training the teaching approach staff.

REJAS DAYCARE & PRE SCHOOL

Description

Rejas Daycare & Pre-School is the English medium institute that offers early childhood and pre-unit education and dedicating for a safe and creative learning environment for the kids between 2 – 5 years to become long-life global learners.

The project offers childcare and interpersonal skills development ranging into swimming, English language for communication, self-discipline, counting, writing, drawing, playing grounds, sports and games, and parental care session.

Mama na Mwana Daycare and babysitters is a private education center that provides childcare, early childhood education and development for the kids less than 5 years. Also, the center offers parental care and extra curriculum program for children between 12 – 18 years during the holiday season.

ZERRY EDUCATION CENTRE

ZERRY Education Center is the daycare and pre-unit school located at Tandale one of the popular slum in Dar es Salaam. The project offers early childhood education and development program for the kids who under 5 years. The centre become amongst the safe place for the children when their parents and guardians are at work.

WATOTO WETU TANZANIA

Description

WATOTO WETU Tanzania is an orphanage that offers food, shelter, clothes and education at the public school for the children who abounded at the street and orphans. The project is the home for over 80 children who are between 2 – 18 years.

In addition, the project runs academic and non-academic program for adolescent mothers who were dropping out of school because of pregnant. Moreover, the project offers daycare and nursery program for the Maasai kids at Mazizi village and its neighborhood in Chalinze.

Volunteer activities

MWANDALIWA ORPHANAGE

Description

MWANDALIWA ORPHANAGE is the home of 75 children and young people under 18 years. The project offers food, shelter, clothes and education at the public school for orphans.

Also, the project runs child development curriculum for the children under 6 years old. The children learn variety mental and physical development literacy such as reading, English speaking, counting, drawing, playing, singing, dancing and writing.

Volunteer activities

- Teaching kids to count in English,
- English language for communication,
- Drawing and painting
- Reading storybook for the kids
- Organizing sports and games for mental and physical strength

WEEDO

Description

WEEDO is an abbreviation of Women Economic Empowerment Development Organization. The project registered under social welfare to advocate for girls' rights particularly in reducing financial inequality through skills development program mainly on sewing, financial & computer literacy, social entrepreneurship and English for communication. Moreover, WEEDO offers personal hygiene management, reproductive health education

The project beneficiaries are girls and young women who are limited access to formal education opportunities and coming from very difficult background.

Volunteer activities

- Teaching sewing and fashion design
- Teaching English language for communication
- Teaching computer literacy
- Teaching financial literacy
- Conducting therapy and counseling activities
- Facilitating sexual and reproductive health education, and life skills
- Supporting online marketing, and content creation

Kigamboni founded in the other part of Dar es Salaam, usually you have to take a ferry or the bridge to cross the ocean to the city centre.

HER INITIATIVE

Description

Her Initiative is a young women-led non-profit organization that works to reframes the value of girls and shapes the new norms that break the cycle of poverty and create financial resilience among adolescent girls and young women in Tanzania in order to achieve gender equality and inclusive economic growth.

The project offers online and local mentorship program for in and out of the school girls with entrepreneurship skills both theoretically and practically, income and capital generation process and financial literacy.

VOYOTA is an abbreviation of Voice of Youth Tanzania which is non-profit organization based in southern Tanzania (Arusha). It was initiated with a sole purpose of inspiring and motivating underserved youth to unlock their potentials and utilize their talents for better future. Recently, the project offers girls economic empowerment program i.e. sewing, computer literacy, and gardening; climate justice i.e. raise awareness program and trees planting in and out of school; and sexual and reproductive health education for young people out of school.

Volunteer activities

- Teaching computer and financial literacy
- Facilitating entrepreneurship and business classes
- Supporting local staff with administration work
- Organizing school outreach life skills program and sexual and reproductive health education

Location

VOYOTA is located in Arusha at USA-River. It approximately 10 hours by bus from Dar es Salaam, about 40 minutes from Kilimanjaro International Airport. Moreover, the distance from USA-River to Arusha town approximately 30 minutes by car and about 5 hours by to Serengeti and Ngorongoro National Park.



NIMUJO EDUTAINMENT CENTRE

Description

The word 'NIMUJO' is developed from southern ethnic group known as MAKONDE translates as "Your Fellow".

NIMUJO Edutainment Centre is a registered NGO which is committed to preserving Tanzanian culture and fostering aspiring artists' development. The project serves as a hub for creative contemporary arts, life skills and sexual reproductive education, and mentorship for emerging artists through its innovative Cultural Garage program.

Tandale and Mwananyama are neighborhoods in Dar es Salaam which have high population and low-income (poor) families.

Description

V4Y is an abbreviation of Vision for Youth, this is a non-profit organization based in southern of Tanzania (Arusha). Through interactive training, evidence-based advocacy, and social campaigns, the project reached thousands of youth to help remove barriers that prevent them from attaining their dreams.

Recently, the project runs three program approaches; health promotion i.e. sexual and reproductive health education, economic empowerment mainly in enhancing access market and investment opportunities for small scale entrepreneurs, and civic engagement in supporting youth participation in regional integration (East Africa Community).

MEHAYO stands for Mental Hand-cap Youth Organization; this is a community-based and non-profit organization that founded to combat all forms of stigmatization among youth with disabilities by teaching them practical skills, such as pottery, gardening, painting, sowing or bracelet making.

The project is based in Morogoro and is a home of 60 children and youth with mental disability who are offered with shelter, food, clothes and education at the public school.

Volunteer activities

- Helps with gardening, arts and crafts or pottery making;
- Conducts physiotherapy and medication session to youth with mental disabilities
- Organizes dance class, painting or sowing
- Brings children to school nearby
- Organize professional work to assist youth with mental disabilities and staff.
- Content creation for social media and marketing

MEHAYO is located at Mazimbu in Morogoro region. It's approximately 4/5 hours by bus from Dar es Salaam and 4 hours by bus to the Capital city of Tanzania (Dodoma). It is estimated 40 minutes by bus to Mikumi National Park, 2 hours to Udzungwa mountain and 20 minutes by feet to Uluguru mountains.

Description

EMFERD is the abbreviation of Erick Memorial Foundation for Education and Rehabilitation for Disabilities. The regular activities are; Community-based Rehabilitation i.e. for physical therapy support, medical integration and equalization of opportunities; Girls Empowerment through Inclusive Education mainly supporting girls who are coming from family with disabled, and Elderly Nursery it elderly women-based program against all form of discrimination for children and youth with disabilities.

Recently, the project is a home of 45 disabled children and 20 girls who are coming from the family with disabled person.

Volunteer activities

- Helps with gardening, arts and crafts or pottery making;
- Conducts physiotherapy and medication session for children and youth with disabilities
- Organizes dance class, painting or sowing
- Teaching children and girls English language
- Conducting community-based rehabilitation activities at the neighborhood.
